Professional Scholarships

Applications due by December 31, 2006.

New and innovative accomplishments on the Web come from all kinds of organizations throughout the world. Archives & Museum Informatics recognizes that many individuals who make significant contributions to the World Wide Web would be unable to attend MW2006 without some financial assistance. Scholarships are available to help offset the costs of attending **MW2006**. Professionals from the developing world are strongly encouraged to apply.

Scholarship Award

A competitive scholarship, covering the full conference registration and a full day of workshops will be awarded to a select number of applicants. In special cases some support may also be offered for travel costs. To be eligible, you must have made a significant contribution to the development of a cultural or heritage Web site, and must demonstrate that you would not be able to attend the meeting without support.

Application Review

The Conference Co-Chairs will review scholarship applications and select recipients. Successful applicants will be those whose involvement in MW2006 is thought to offer the most value to the applicant and to others in attendance. Applications from the developing world will be given preference. To highlight new work, scholarship recipients will present their Web sites at the MW2006 **Demonstration Sessions** March 25, 2006.

Application Procedures

To apply for a scholarship, you must submit the **MW2006** Scholarship Application Form. You will be asked to outline your reasons for wanting to come to Museums and the Web 2006, and to explain how your work contributes to the development of museum Web sites. Your application must include the URL of your organization's Web site and a description of your specific role in the creation of that site. You **must** be recommended by a superior in your institution (preferably your immediate supervisor), who must confirm the details of your contribution to the cultural or heritage Web site referenced.

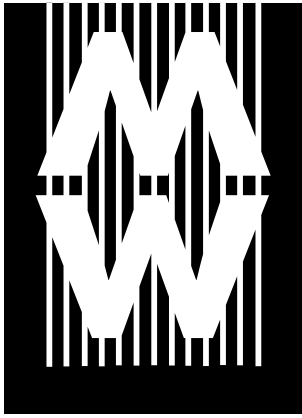
Application Deadline

Applications must be received at the Museums and the Web conference office by **December 31, 2005**. You may e-mail MW2006@archimuse.com, fax +1 416 352 6025, or send your application by mail to MW2006 Scholarships, Archives & Museum Informatics, 158 Lee Avenue, Toronto, Ontario M4E 2P3 Canada, if it is sure to arrive in time.

Conditions of Acceptance

If awarded a Scholarship, you will be asked to assure the Conference Co-Chairs that you will make every effort to acquire all other funding necessary to attend the meeting. By no later than February 1, 2006, you must certify that you will attend Museums and the Web 2006. If you are not able to do so, your scholarship will be awarded to another deserving applicant.
